- A compromised ability to speak, chew or eat



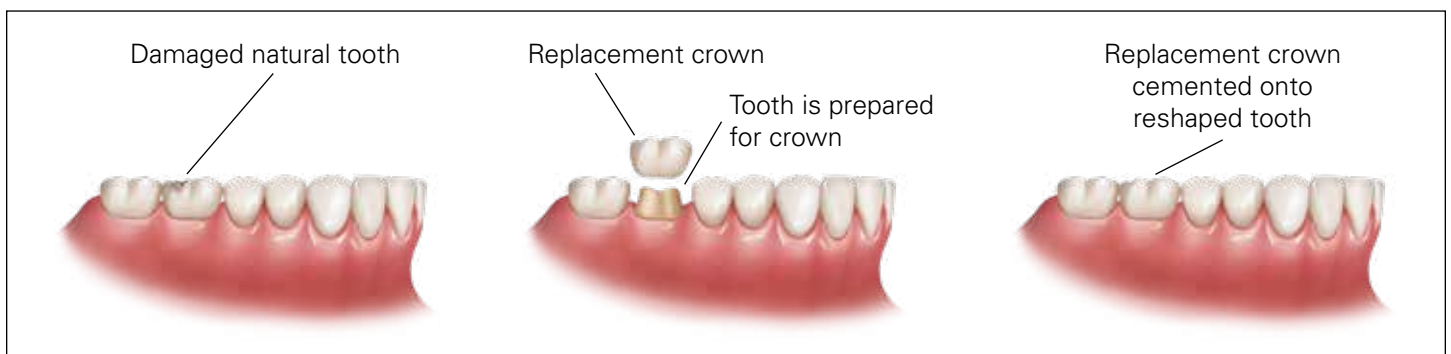
A Crown or Bridge Can Help You!

Crowns and bridges are custom-made dental prostheses that go over your natural tooth structure to restore function and improve the appearance of your smile. They are some of the most common dental treatments provided by dentists today and they're available in a variety of different materials to fit your specific health needs and budget.

HOW CROWNS AND BRIDGES WORK

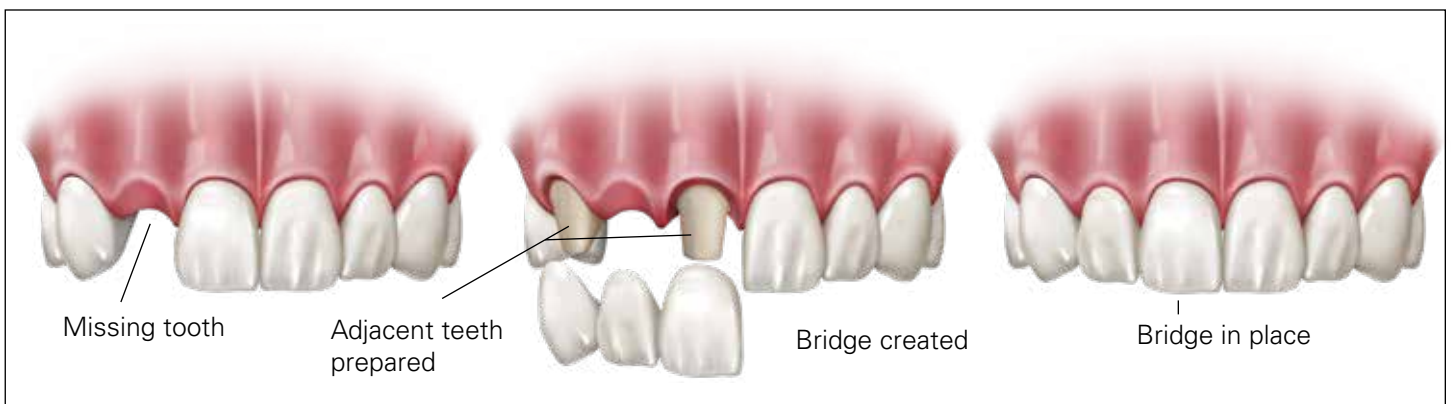
If your dentist determines a crown or bridge is the right treatment for you, the process is straightforward and delivers fantastic results. First, your dentist removes a portion of your natural tooth. Then, the custom-made crown or bridge is cemented over your reshaped tooth, serving as a replacement tooth to improve the appearance and function of your smile.

The Crown Procedure



Crowns are designed to treat a single tooth, though your dentist may elect to use multiple crowns in tandem if your health situation requires it.

The Bridge Procedure



A bridge is designed to treat a span of multiple teeth. One common usage for bridges is to replace a missing tooth, with your adjacent healthy teeth serving as support for the bridge.

BENEFITS OF CROWNS AND BRIDGES

Crowns and bridges offer many similar benefits, with the primary difference between the two treatment options being the number of teeth or the size of area that requires care.



Crowns

- Replaces a broken tooth
- Protects cracked, worn or sensitive teeth
- Improves the appearance of a discolored or badly shaped tooth
- Replaces old, failing dental work, such as a composite filling



Bridges

- Replaces one or more missing teeth
- Prevents healthy teeth from drifting into spaces created by missing teeth
- Improves a patient's ability to speak, chew and eat

Considerations

Every patient's oral health is unique. Your dentist can help you determine which treatment option is most appropriate for your specific smile goals, health situation and budget. Some of the factors your dentist will consider when helping you determine whether a crown or bridge is right for you include:

- The health and appearance of your natural tooth structure
- The health and appearance of the teeth adjacent to the treatment area
- The integrity of your gum tissue and jaw bone
- Your oral hygiene habits

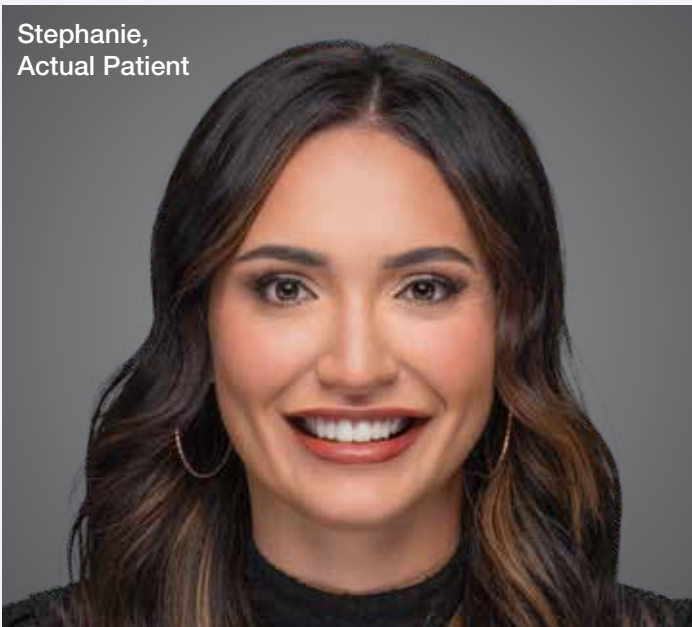
